Check master cylinder/servo for leaks and operations	✓	✓

Check all tyres (condition, suitability, wear, tread depth and inflation)	✓	✓
Set wheel nut torque to correct setting	✓	✓
Check if winter tyres fitted (recommended fitting between October to March)	✓	✓

Check condition of car accessories (e.g carpet mats)	✓	✓
